I'm using the following software tools to promote my blogs and build links:

- \* RSSBot - automates RSS feed submission
- \* Social Bot - automates bookmarking on social bookmarking sites
- \* Web2.0Bot - automates account creation on Web 2.0 properties, and last but not least
- \* Deep Linker Pro - for automated directory submissions

Each of these apps are relatively low cost - around \$30.00 and I believe I paid \$47.00 for DeepLinkerPro.

If you're just starting out you can do all this manually of course. However, these tools can save you a lot of time.

Standalone (outside WP):

- Bookmarkwiz for bookmarking.
- RSS Bot
- SocialAdr for more bookmarking.

Inside the WP Dashboard:

- WebTrafficGenius (Automated RSS submissions)
- WP Syndicator of Andy Fletcher (Automated syndication of your posts to the top web 2.0 sites)

Yes, some of the links above are affiliate links. If you find this inappropriate you can google the sites yourself and find the salespage this way ;)

Just wanted to let you know the plugins I am using with good results and with minimum work.

RSS Bot is a stand-alone tool. You have to open the software, get a company profile, account profile and fill in all the other details. I use this tool myself for non WP sites.

Web Traffic Genius is a plugin that submits and updates your WP site feed each and everytime you post on auto pilot to 30 RSS submission sites. There is an update around the corner and the list of sites will be 50. All the well known RSS sites are in the list.

You install and configure the plugin once on a WP site and it works like a charm. No need to open other RSS software outside the site.

Onlywire, I am not familiar with this. Never used it. But I can explain the other tools a bit more:

Bookmarkwiz: A standalone tool that bookmarks your site/URL to the top bookmarking sites. An option to upload proxies, gmailaccounts, decaptcher details etc etc. The software registers at the Bookmarking sites, confirms everything. You can register a lot of accounts with different gmail accounts and the software picks one of them. When one account is down, he takes another one to make sure you get a high succes rate.

SocialAdr: Super simple to use. You have to login into their backoffice. Nothing to download to your pc. In the backoffice you can enter a spinnable title, description and multiple tags. Depending on your account you get a lot of credits per month and when your site is bookmarked the backoffice deducts your credits.

Who is bookmarking your sites? Well, I have a paid subscription and therefore get about 50 credits a day. But there are also members who don't pay the monthly subscription, but earn credits by submitting sites that are delivered to them via the backoffice (i.e. my site details). After they submitted the sites of the paying members, they can add their own sites also.

The big advantage here is, I am not bookmarking my sites through my own bookmarking accounts, but the bookmarking is done by a lot of free members of SocialAdr and therefore spread out over a lot of different IP-adresses and bookmarking accounts. In the eyes of Google this is more natural and effective than just one or two bookmarks done by just me.

In case someone wants to subscribe to SocialAdr, please send me a PM here. I can give you a coupon code of 20% discount of the monthly fee (for all 3 packages), but I can't post this code in a public forum.

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Tools for Autoblogs ....

I purchased Rank builder to see if it was a good senuke substitute, sadly not, well not yet anyway... I cancelled that this week and carried on with senuke... I am running a submission as I write this post! Used the right way this is a great tool (the right way means lightly and carefully not as a splog and spam machine!) and i cant wait for the upgrade due later this year senukeX... costs \$127 per month - ouch!

web traffic genius - not a simple one click install plugin but worth the effort - great for autoblogs as rss is all automatic.... new upgrade will automatically post rss for existing posts as well (when it is released...) was about \$67 i think - one off fee

for a cheap blog submission service ezarticlelink is a good one = \$29 per month. You can use all your existing ezine articles, they will spin for \$3 for you (i hate spinning) and then you can put in some changes if you like. Or use plr...for spinning. Then you submit to about 200+ sites in special libraries or directories. These are user owed blogs and static sites. You have to supply an indexed site for the use of others and then can add a site of your own. You get credits for each article you put in and this gives you some profile links as well. They ensure your articles are indexed by backlinking them for you. I have tons of links coming in for the submissions I have made. If someone drops out of the loop they replace your links on new sites.

Caroline Middlebrooks IMAutomator - its free - does 15 backlinks for you and you can do 10 bookmark projects per day = 150 links- this is so easy its untrue - sign up for a free account and see. Gives PR2-6 bookmarking site links. Great for autoblogs, web2 sites and ezinearticles.....!

plus write some ezinearticles and look forthe odd .edu and .gov link opportunities

There is a small learning curve and I can recommend to follow the included user guides. Once you've done it once or twice it becomes easy...

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Here's what I have been using to build backlinks to ny autoblogs:  
Wordpress backlink creator plugin  
(aff link)

This is a Wordpress plugin. You only have to install it on ONE of your blogs and you can use it to promote ALL of your blogs.

There are thousands of blogs with this plugin installed.  
This creates a massive blog network that you can use to build links with.

It features two completely separate link building functions:

1. Link distribution for Blog Sidebar links

You have the ability to add up to 500 keyword anchored backlinks into the plugin.  
Your links will then be randomly rotated on the sidebars of other blogs with the backlink creator plugin installed.  
This will create an evergrowing list of sidebar backlinks to your target sites.

2. Article Distribution for in context blog post links

You add articles containing your backlinks to the plugin, and select one or more categories for article distribution.  
Your articles are then distributed as posts on other blogs with the backlink creator plugin installed that are in your nominated category.  
This automatically generates IN CONTEXT blog post links back to your sites.

Where do I get the articles to add my links to?

I use blog posts pulled in by Carty's software!

Everytime I use Carty's software I just copy a couple of posts from the software into notepad, add my backlinks, then submit them to the Wordpress backlink creator plugin.
