The software doesn't spin in the actual sense the way a spinner does, i.e replace specific words with others. The way you create unique content is with the translation function. You can add as many translations as you like, ex: German to French to Italian to Spanish to English.

If your original rss feed was in English, with this many translations it will definitely look completely different than what you started with giving you completely unique content.

If you are worried about copyright violations, just take a bit more time and locate feeds that don't have copyright restrictions.

As far as getting the count . . . I'm afraid I'll have to leave that to someone who has more experience with the program.
