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Hello there, Yes its annoying when you can only log in to wordpress but the free Blogger site wont let you in.

Mr Carty and Costomer support took ages to get back to me, but did in the end and gave me a clue to solving this.

Here it is.

You need to go to google and log into your Gmail account to make sure that works. If you have not got a

Gmail account you must set one up aswell as setting up a Blogger account. ALL are run by google. Your user name and password should be the same for all 3. Blogger,Gmail and Google.

Once you have done this go to the ABS software and click on ADD NEW Blog, select Blogger, then Enter your Gmail user name in FULL.  
ie your full Gmail address, so if your address is STEVE@Gmail.com then that is what you enter as your user name. Then enter your password.

That is where Iwas going wrong, by forgetting to add the @Gmail as part of the user name.. If it still doesnt work try changing you Gmail address and user name by going to google settings.

Hope that helps? Let me know.

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Wande,

Just follow Ryalman's instructions above and it should work.

Basically you need to link your Blogger account to Gmail. Google offers the opportunity to link all of your Google accounts (Adsense, Blogger, etc) to a Gmail login. You will then be able to use you Gmail login or your original email login to access these accounts. However, with ABS, it seems only to work with the Gmail login.

ie My log in was something like Gary@Blueyonder.co.uk ..... so When I tried to log in to the ABS software and connect to Blogger I entered my user name as Gary@Blueyonder.co.uk@Gmail ..... this has too many @ symbols and the ABS software cant handle it ....

change your Gmail user name to something simple like Gary@Gmail.com ... obviously not Gary :-) but you see what I mean ... then your user name to access blogger will be Gary@Gmail.com and you should see it works fine .... hope that helps ....

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Well, I had my doubts at first, after another similar bit of autoblog software refused to work for me. But I can assure you that THIS softare from webmagnates does work.

Try removing and uninstaling it.

Then Re-check your Gmail user name. Make sure it is something simple that you can tag @gmail on the end.

Then this email address becomes your blogger log in.

Re-inatall the ABS software and click on add new blog, select blogger , enter the user name (your gmail address) then enter your password.

Tip: Make sure your software works with wordpress first. If you cant access your WP Blogs then it wont work with blogger.

Oh and I am assuming YOU HAVE set up a blogger blog and a WP blog FIRST ....
