I don't know if this is possible or not, but it would be pretty cool if there were a way to add a feed and randomly distribute the contents across multiple blogs.

For example, say I have 100 blogs set up, and I've got a list of 1000 backlinks that I want to get indexed. Right now what I am doing is going to links2rss.com, converting the links into 100 different feeds with 10 links each, and adding each feed to one of my 100 blogs with a link pointing to the original article. It would be awesome though if I could just create one feed with 1000 links and there was a way to add 10 items from the feed to each of my 100 blogs.

Is that possible? It would be pretty awesome, and would make the Autoblogging Software even more powerful than Backlinks Energizer and Backlinks Index Express for rapidly getting backlinks indexed.
