

## [Help] "Invalid Key" Message

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Ok, so you have purchased the software and was sent a unique product key to activate the software but get an invalid key message when trying to activate?

This is because of the stupid UAC settings introduced after Vista. You can turn it off from Control Panel > User accounts menu. Make sure you restart your PC after turning it off and try again, it should work.

Alternatively you can try running the software in administrator mode by right clicking on the program icon and selecting "Run as administrator" option.

If you still get the invalid key message, don't worry, just contact me back by replying to the email you received with the product key and provide me the Computer name exactly as shown in the activation page of the software. I will then send you a manual activation file for your PC.

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Actually when you copy paste the key received in the email, an extra space is added at the end resulting in "Invalid Key" message. Please try again by typing in the key manually, case sensitive. If it still says the same, send me the Computer Name exactly as shown in the activation page of the software and I can send you a manual activation key file.
