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Alex, randomization of posts mean, say you download 5 articles from a feed and post the same 5 articles on your blog. The posts are made in the same order as appeared in the source blog which is what will be randomized in this new version.

Regarding the link back to original article, it is the setting that you have to make. While adding a new feed or editing an already added feed, there is an option called "Post Template". You can remove it there. Anything added there will also be added to your posts.
